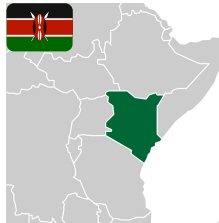

Arbor Oils of Africa produces steam distilled, certified organic and FairWild frankincense essential oil from wild harvested gums. These are collected by pastoralist women in the semi deserts of north Kenya. The collection areas are community owned and cover 350,000 hectares.

Our philosophy is (a) to ensure sustainable harvest of the resins. No tapping is done. Collection is from natural exudation. (b) To ensure traceability and fair prices. Collectors are paid cash on delivery above the market prices. (c) To stimulate pastoralists with a desire to protect this valuable natural resource (d) To produce consistent quality frankincense essential oil which is matured in glass vats for a minimum of 6 months in order to produce a pleasant, rounded, fruity odour.

SOYMAX is a Togolese company that markets soy, cashew, sesame, and pineapple with a keen sense and particular dedication to quality. Its products are organic, 100% pure and natural, and exclusively of Togolese origin.

Their mission is to develop and promote the cultivation of organic produce in Togo and organize the collection of organic products to help reduce unemployment. It was founded in 2018 in one of Togo's most fertile regions: the Atakpamé quartier Sada, in the Plateaux region.

SOYMAX initially started with ten agents who covered 3000 producers, and produced 2000 to 3000 tonnes. However, as of 2021, the company has grown and worked with 4,500 producers for 8,000 tonnes. Currently, SOYMAX has 27 employees who work with over 6,400 producers, producing a total of 16,960 tonnes. The company places a particular emphasis on the involvement of women in its operations.

SOYMAX has developed a control system that specifically monitors all organic standards processes throughout the value chain. To ensure high-quality organic products, the company provides farmers with high-quality, certified organic seeds and technical know-how, along with special monitoring.
