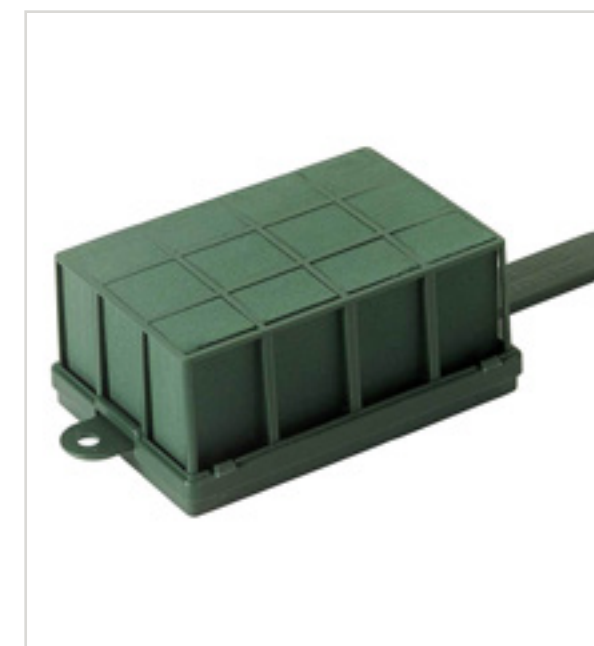
## Blind Flower Design Challenge BY BALL

WHAT YOU NEED

- Manzanita Branches **8 to 10**
- Metal Structure **1**
- Bunches Limonium **80**
- Bunches Potoac Snapdragon **7**
- Bunches Campanula Campana **7**
- Zip Ties **30**
- Roll Bindwire **1**
- Grande Oasis Cages **4**
- Roll Coconut Husk **1**
- Dixon Pins **12**





PRO TIPS:

-  
Branches are a great starting point. They help to build volume and create a natural grid.

## Step 1.

Affix Manzanita branches to metal structure with zip ties.



## Step 3.

Pose for a “Big Bunch Photo” before finishing all your individual bouquets.



## Step 4.

Use the Color Block method to group your blooms.



## Step 2.

Create individual bouquets of Limonium bound in bindwire. Use approximately 2 bunches of Limonium per bouquet.



PRO TIPS:

-  
Color Blocking gives dramatic impact even in the simplest designs.



## Step 5.

Attach individual soaked Oasis Sausage Links to your structure with zip ties.



## Step 8.

Wrap cages with Coconut Husk or Moss secured with Dixon Pins to hide mechanics.



## Step 6.

Insert Campanula into Oasis Links.

## Step 7.

Place Snapdragons in cages.



## Step 9.

Place cages on the ground in front of structure.

### PRO TIPS:

- Use Dixon Pins instead of U-Pins when working on wet foam.



## Step 10.

Step back, enjoy what you have created and don't forget to pause for a photo.
