Aris History

1920

- Ira and Menno Yoder founded **Yoder Brothers**, now **Aris Horticulture, Inc.**, with the purchase of the world's largest greenhouse complex (20 acres) located in Barberton, Ohio

1930s to 1940s

- Chrysanthemum production and breeding begins with cut mums
- Crop health, virus-indexing program developed – a core focus area to this day

1950s to 1960s

- Greenhouse facilities added in Florida
- World's largest horticultural company geared to supplying growers (GrowerTalks, 1961)

1970s

- Purchase of greenhouse facility in Leamington, Ontario
- Expansion into potted plants for supermarket retail

1980s

- Keepsake® Azalea** and **Tradewinds Hibiscus™** breeding programs begin

1990s

- Breeding breakthrough – Pelee is 1st bicolor pot mum
- Green Leaf Plants** founded, adding perennials to the mix
- Perennial line launched internationally
- Green Leaf Plants moved into newly constructed facility in Lancaster, PA (1998)

2000 to Present

- 1st clean stock, plant-health protocols established for perennials
- Yoder Brothers, Inc. changes name to Aris Horticulture, Inc. when Yoder® mum brand sold to Syngenta
- Must Have Perennials®** pursues a two-brand marketing strategy and grows its Rozanne and Friends® consumer brand to 110,000 followers through social media
