Total Canadian Potato Storage Holdings on March 1 in Eastern Canada are 0.8% above their three- year average. PEI holds the largest inventory of potatoes with stocks similar to 2018 and 2017. In Western Canada, BC stocks are 17% below their 3-yr. average. Manitoba holdings are 13.4% below their 3-yr. average.
